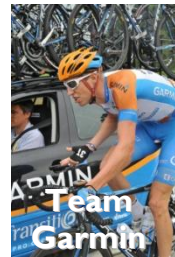

Bicycles for Humanity Colorado

Bicycles for Humanity Colorado (B4H) is delivering bicycles! In fact, the B4H team is leaving for Namibia four days after the Gala to set up their next bike shop!

Namibia Update – B4H has shipped 800 bikes this year and the total number of bikes sent to Namibia by B4H is 1,500!



The third bike shop is set to officially open in the small village of Bunya during the first week in October. The bike container has arrived in the village and the selection of the bike shop team has begun.

B4H chooses villages where they can partner with a local aid agency. Consistent with previous B4H projects, local healthcare workers receive free bikes to use as transport for their home-based care programs. Profits from the bike shop support the local aid organization.

In Nkurenkruru, the site of B4H's first bike shop, business has been strong enough to support the opening of a kindergarten in one of the bike shipping containers. The Siurungu School hosts 50 students split into half-day programs. Part of the October trip to Namibia will be spent building desks and shelves, painting the school and adding windows to make the school a cool learning environment. It's exciting to see the blossoming of B4H programs well beyond bikes and to watch them making a deeper impact in the communities served.

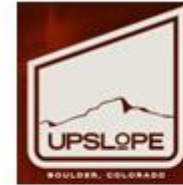
